

## **Child Safety Seats**

Motor vehicle crashes are the leading killer of children ages 4-14 annually. Research shows that the majority of the 20 million at-risk children (generally kids between the ages of four and eight or around 40-80 pounds, unless they are 4'9" in height) are not properly secured while riding in automobiles. In partnership with the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA), the National Automobile Dealers Association has embarked on a national education and awareness campaign to promote booster seat use.
